Presenters Mr. Patrick Power RSW and Edmonton Elder Abuse Intervention Team members

All of us can do our part to stop Elder abuse if we know what to look for and how to support those individuals experiencing abuse. Dental professionals are in a unique position to identify those senior who may be in need of protection from abusers. "Often seniors don't recognize that they are being abused because over time the behavior has become the norm in the family. This gradual process masks the seriousness of the situation and seniors need to understand that this isn't how they should be treated." 2:30 pm **WHAT EVERY DENTAL PROFESSIONAL SHOULD KNOW ABOUT DENTAL INSURANCE**
Presenter Dolores Berezowsky, Senior Manager of Dental Services - Alberta Blue Cross



All dental team members require a basic understanding of dental insurance to be able to answer questions their patients may have about their insurance coverage. While few people will have all the knowledge on every plan there are some commonalities that will apply to most plans. Specifics that are unique to each patient's insurance plan and circumstances will need to be addressed by those staff members responsible for submitting claim forms. Dolores will discuss a number of issues related to dental insurance claims. She will explain how dental insurance works, some common insurance plan designs, and why some services aren't covered. While Alberta Dentists are not currently under a common fee guide, each insurance company will base their payments on a guide that they have adopted for use. Each dental service procedure has a code assigned to it for payment purposes. Dolores will provide some procedure code definitions for those most commonly misinterpreted. The insurance companies do see common claiming errors and this presentation will address those errors and how they can be easily corrected.
